Subject: how to use the visual experience as a teaching tool for children

Session 1: focus on finding creativity in every child through the visual experience of the arts. Learn, for example, how to help them discover the basic elements of art and design in their everyday surroundings.

In hands on situations, learn how to present these design elements to children in all 3 learning modes: Auditory, Visual and Kinesthetic.

Session 2: focus on helping children achieve success in the area of visual experience and, most importantly, how to translate that success into other areas of learning that are a struggle for them.

Learn also how to use a child's interest in other areas such as sports, the sciences, etc. and translate what they have learned in those areas into success in the area of visual experience.
