- Offer recreation classes for young children under 5 years of age (tumbling & gymnastics).
- Additional advertisement of recreation classes (i.e. library).
- Consider hook-ups for electric cars.
- Examine cost of city's contribution to Public Employment Retirement System (PERS).
- Help in refurbishing dilapidated buildings (i.e. Booth Hotel).
- Promote middle-income housing.
- Encourage I-5 opportunities; consider Master Plan for Westside.
- Consider Redevelopment District.
- Enforce Building Inspection standards.
- Enforce signage and maintenance of downtown properties.
- Promote Black Butte Lake.
- Consider Federal funding for bike paths, sidewalks, and infrastructure.
- Consider local contractors for new development projects.
- Protect air and water resources.
- Consider the City's Sphere of Influence in the Asset Inventory.
- Can the City afford a new Public Safety Facility? Where is the funding coming from?

- What is the approximate percentage of low-income housing in the City?
- Need to develop a plan for job opportunities.
