ADMINISTRATIVE COMMUNICATIONS

Finance Director:

Finance Director Brock brought forward the Final Audit Report ended June 30, 2010 for review and approval. Finance Director Brock stated the audit firm Marcello and Company has given the City a fair and excellent opinion on behalf of the financial statements presented.

City Engineer:

City Engineer Skillman gave an update on the signal project at Papst Avenue and State Route 32. Mr. Skillman stated that the Hibdon's curb and gutter was intended to be performed under an encroachment permit rider, but Caltrans changed their mind following submission of the plan for same. A separate encroachment permint was applied for by the Hibdon's and it was during this review that Caltrans came up with 23 items in the hydrology department. Subsequently, Mr. Rabo from Rolls, Anderson & Rolls met with Caltrans on Tuesday, March 1st and verbally received commitment from Caltrans to keep the hydrology review to a site specific analysis. Under that scenario, Mr. Skillman believes that the Hibdon's permit will receive approval early this week and the project will be back under construction soon thereafter.

City Engineer Skillman request Council to adopt Resolution No. 2011-01 approving the Agreement for Landscape Maintenance within State Highway Right-of-Way on Route 32 within the City of Orland.

City Engineer Skillman request Council to approve the Deferred Improvement Agreement with Baldwin-Minkler Farms and authorize Mayor to execute the Agreement. The agreement would be needed for future improvements along the west side of Papst Avenue and south of South Street.

Councilmember Gee moved, seconded by Councilmember Hoffman to approve the Deferred Improvement Agreement with Baldwin-Minkler Farms and authorize the Mayor to execute the same. Motion carried with no abstentions and Mayor Paschall absent.

City Manager:

City Manager Poczobut brought forward discussion regarding State of California Community Block Grant Funding. City Manager Poczobut advised CDBG has suspended the Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) for 2011, as funding is proposed to be cut by 62%. The next funding of NOFA will be released in 2012. Staff will be determine whether to apply for funding for a grocery and hotel feasibility study and possibly a Public Facilities Grant for the police facility or repairs for the swimming pool.

City Manager Poczobut gave an update on the HVAC system at City Hall, Library and Corporation Yard. City Manager Poczobut advised the HVAC replacement project will begin in approximately two to four weeks after approval of the prevailing wage report that was submitted by Efficient Energy Concepts Inc.
