ADMINISTRATIVE COMMUNICATIONS

City Manager:

City Manager Carr presented information on various budget adjustments that were identified from the last Council meeting. The proposed final budget will be presented to Council at the regularly scheduled meeting on June 16th. Risk Management costs are increasing 4.8%, less than first anticipated. Mr. Carr advised Fire Cost Recovery is not recommended at this time. Recommended changes are being made to the allocation of the City Attorney's budget and no changes anticipated with the City Planner budget. Mr. Carr advised staff proposed changes to the Building Inspector position into a full-time position due to the influx of development activity. Revisions in finance-related staff assignments at City Hall are also taking place. Mr. Carr reviewed FY15 Project Objectives for next year. Mr. Carr did add - Secure access (vehicular access) to Stony Creek at the east and west ends of Stony Creek Drive; establish a new downtown signage program; and seek updated agreement with OUWA regarding canals. Mayor Paschall requested a review of the objectives at the next scheduled meeting.
