General Plan Amendment – Review and Recommendation to adopt and incorporate the updated Multi-Jurisdiction Hazard Mitigation Plan 2025 into the Safety Element of the City of Orland General Plan: The proposed General Plan Amendment (GPA) 2025-01 is intended to amend the City of Orland General Plan by including an update to the Multi-Jurisdiction Hazard Mitigation Plan (MJHMP) prepared in conjunction Glenn County, pending adoption and approval by the City Council of the City of Orland. Glenn County Board of Supervisors, the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (CalOES) and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) have conditionally approved the MJHMP 2025 update. The proposed approval and adoption of the MJHMP recognizes the County and Cities' commitment to reducing the impacts of natural hazards. The proposed action is a recommendation from the Planning Commission to the City Council.

The proposal action is exempt from environmental review as required by CEQA through the use of the "General Rule" Section 15061(b) (3) that is applied to proposals, which will have no potential adverse impact on the environment.

The public is invited to review and comment on these matters.
