Following the second public hearing, draft maps of potential Council election district boundaries will be published on or before March 31, 2026, for consideration and public input at the third and fourth public hearings.

At the April 7 and April 21 hearings, the public is invited to provide input regarding the content of the draft maps and the proposed sequence of elections.
